

The past and future rub shoulders, with Flemish and Spanish inspiration for the historical facades of Old town (Vieux-Lille) and the contemporary architectural monuments to the glory of industry and innovation. It's a gourmet city with thousands of flavours and as just as many breweries to pair them with. Lille Metropole has been designated 2020 World Design Capital.

Equestrian art :


Visit of the Equestrian Academy of Versailles to discover the heritage of the royal stables.

Chantilly

World famous for its cream, Chantilly also owes its prestige to the Domaine de Chantilly, one of the jewels of France's cultural heritage. Located in a preserved natural setting, close to Paris, the Domaine de Chantilly was built up from the Middle Ages and today it is home to the Château, the Gardens and the Great Stables (the largest stables in Europe).

Castle : Guided tours or self-guided tours with audio guides

Gardens : A veritable testimony to the history of the gardens, the vast 115-hectare gardens of the Domaine de Chantilly provide a relaxing gate away experience. Fun guided tour of the grounds in the touristic train or guided visit on a discovery shuttle, segway, 4-wheel bicycles, bikes, electric scooters or boats.

Around the whipped cream : Taste and learn to cook

Lunch at the heart of the Château to enjoy the authentic traditional French cuisine ! Followed by a Chantilly whipped cream demonstration by the Chef and of course the degustation. After the tasting, time for practice with a culinary workshop.

Immersion in the equestrian world :

-Great Stables of Domaine de Chantilly : Considered to be the most beautiful in Europe, with their impressive dimensions, these 18th century stables are a veritable palace for horses. Dressage demonstration : The riders demonstrate their work in dressage and their preparations for the equestrian shows.

-Discovery of horse and carriage :

Horse-drawn carriage rides in the heart of the national forest of Chantilly and on the training tracks of racehorses. Or introductions to learn the particularities of this little-known sport.

-Introduction to Polo : Theory and horseback practice to discover and be able to "hit" the ball in forehand at a walk, trot or gallop.

-Chantilly Racecourse : One of the oldest tracks in France, Internationally renowned horse races are held here.

Inside the Racecourse" guided tour Get to discover how a race meeting is organised and step behind the scenes in these exceptional racing venues. Lunch with panoramic view.



REIMS

In Reims, discover more than 2,000 years of history: Reims Cathedral with its incredible architecture, the Tau Palace and the former Saint-Rémi abbey are registered on the UNESCO World Heritage list. Reims is also the unofficial capital of the champagne-producing region.

Segway tour of Reims :

Guided tour of the historic city center and visit of the monuments. Break during the visit to taste local products like the Biscuit Rose. With its pink color and white topping, the pink biscuit from Reims is recognizable by all. It has been the pride of the inhabitants of Reims for centuries and can be enjoyed without moderation, accompanied by a flute of Champagne.

The universe of Champagne :

Go behind the scenes of the most prestigious of wines. Immerse yourself in the world of Champagne, whose famous Reims Houses (Vranken-Pommery, Mumm, Moët & Chandon) are home to 120 km of cellars and underground galleries, some dating from the Gallo-Roman era, these cellars are listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Then, move away from the city, and travel the Champagne Tourist Route. There, in the heart of one of the most prestigious wine regions in the world, you will discover the typical villages of Champagne. The wine-growers who live there will share with passion the secrets of Champagne making.


Visit of a famous Champagne house – Mumm Expérience (or another one) : Spread across almost 25 kilometers in the heart of the city of Reims, the underground passageways of the Mumm cellars are home to almost 200 years of history, expertise and passion. The famous water lily ponds and colourful gardens created by the Master of Impressionism, Claude Monet, have made this tiny village famous all over the world.



Rouen

Capital of Normandy with its cathedral, the tallest in France (151m), a majestic building of Gothic.



Fécamp

Framed by the impressive white cliffs of the Alabaster Coast, this historic seaside town was home to the Dukes of Normandy. Also, home to the famous Benedictine liqueur.



Etretat

The cliffs are a unique landscape in the world which have inspired a large number of French artists, writers and painters.



Honfleur

The old port lined with authentic houses ranging from the 16th to the 18th century, inspired artists such as Claude Monet.



Deauville

Internationally renowned seaside resort known for its Casino, high-end hotels, famous boardwalk and horse races.



Cabourg

A romantic seaside resort with its golden beach, racecourse, casino, Grand Hotel and beautiful waterfront villas.

Orléans

Tour of Loire Valley in 2CV :

From the coastal town of Golfe-Juan in the Alpes Maritimes, the Napoleon Road crosses fantastic scenic mountains. This 325-kilometre-long tourist road also passes through pretty towns and villages worth stopping at including. It leads from the French Riviera to the southern Pre-Alps. An itinerary full of culture and dotted with grandiose landscapes !

After Grasse, the atmosphere of the Côte d'Azur fades, the road begins to become more winding and steeper and the landscapes become more and more mountainous.

Castellane, so picturesque village dominated by its rock, mixes its personality as a former strategic site and the charm of a small Provençal town. It is also the gateway to the Gorges du Verdon, the largest Canyon in Europe and a paradise for whitewater sports and hiking.

Digne-les-Bains, no longer quite Provençal, but not Alpine either, it is the capital of lavender and allows you to discover blue gold, the symbol of Provence, in all its forms. The city is also synonymous with relaxation with its world-famous thermal springs.

Sisteron, known for its Medieval citadel which overlooks the city and with its staircase of 365 steps carved into the rock. The old town, at the foot of its citadel, is organized in the form of a labyrinth of alleys, ramps and stairs where one wanders off. The city is ranked among the "100 most beautiful detours in France".

Tallard and its 14th century medieval castle, then direction **Gap**. Very quickly, the landscapes change, once Gap is reached, the Alps finally appear. Kilometre after kilometre, Napoleon is reassured at finding that his popularity remains intact. If one place had to be remembered, it would be the town of Laffrey. This is where at the "prairie of encounter", the future emperor will summon the royal army to join his own troops. The route then leads all the way to its destination at **Grenoble**.



LYON

Lyon, with more than 2,000 years of history, has been shaped over the years. Listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1998, Lyon's 4 historic districts cover 500 hectares and will take you back in time : Vieux Lyon, Croix-Rousse, Presqu'île and Fourvière, each one has its own specific characteristics and is worth discovering.

Vieux Lyon : Old Lyon has retained all the charm of its Renaissance small streets. Secret and mysterious, Vieux-Lyon can be discovered behind the gates, where traboules (hidden passages connecting two streets passing through the interior of a building) and interior courtyards.

Croix-Rousse: The second Lyon hill where past and present mingle, between visits to traditional silk workshops and shops of young designers. La Croix-Rousse is an artist district where street art is displayed in the streets.

Fourvière : The oldest hill in Lyon preserves the remains of Lugdunum, capital of Gaul under the Roman Empire. The Fourvière basilica, a symbol of Lyon stands proudly at the top of the hill and offers a magnificent panorama of the city.

Presqu'île :The heart of Lyon beats between the Rhône and the Saône, to the rhythm of shopping streets and arteries lined with luxury brands. At nightfall, fountains and emblematic monuments light up to rediscover Lyon in light.
